### St. John Eudes After-School Sports Program 2015 -2016 SY

**Dear Parents:** 

If you would like your child to participate in the St. John Eudes Sports Program this year, you must sign and return the bottom portion of this letter, give written permission by signing and returning the After-School Sports Registration form and both you & your child must sign and return the Athletic Code of Conduct Contract. All of these documents must be completed and returned in order for your child to participate in our sports program and play on any of our sports teams. You will also find in this packet, optional forms which if signed and returned would permit your child to walk home after the sports program ends each day and the order form for our sports uniform (All players must purchase their own uniform. You may use the purchased uniform every year, until notified about the change of design).

The purpose of this letter is to make sure you are aware of the procedures established by St. John Eudes School to transport, supervise, and provide medical care for your child when on trips to other sites for athletic events.

- 1. Privately owned vehicles will provide transportation to all athletic events.
- 2. The drivers must be at least 21 years old (usually parents), have a valid California driver's license, and have proof of insurance. They must have fingerprinting clearance, and be trained in VIRTUS.
- 3. All vehicles must be equipped with the proper number of seatbelts. All the students assigned to that vehicle must use the seatbelts.
- 4. The adult drivers will supervise the students in their vehicle during the transportation to and from the athletic event site. The coach or agent of the school will assume responsibility for the children at the athletic event's site.
- 5. In the event further medical attention is necessary, you or the person you designate will be contacted immediately. If an emergency situation arises, a fire department response team will be requested (911).
- 6. No child will be left unattended at any time or in any place. The child is responsible for obeying all directives given by those individuals assuming the role of supervisor.
- 7. Students who are absent from school may NOT participate in After School Sports on practice or game days the day of absence.

### St. John Eudes After-School Sports Registration

St. John Eudes School will offer an after-school sports program for all S.J.E. boys and girls in grades 5 – 8. The program will run from Wednesday, September 2nd, 2015 until approximately May 27, 2016. The program begins at 2:55 PM and finishes at 4:30 PM every Monday – Thursday (except on shortened days or as announced by the Athletic Director/Principal– there will be NO PROGRAM on those days). During this program, we have tryouts/evaluations, practice, and games for our interscholastic sports teams. From September – November we offer boys flag-football and girls volleyball. From December - February we offer boys and girls basketball. From March – May we offer boys volleyball and girls softball. A fee of **\$70 per student per sport** is required to help defer athletic expenses. If you wish for your child (ren) to participate, you must return the signed bottom portion of this form, with the fee, along with the signed St. John Eudes School Athletic Contract and the introduction letter. All three forms must be returned before your child (ren) may participate in the program.

#### Please Note:

- 1. After-school sports finishes at 4:30 pm. Those enrolled in the Extended Day Program (EDP) must sign in at 4:30 (or after the games, when the sports season begins).
- 2. Students in grade TK 4 must be enrolled in the Enrichment/ Extended Care Program to stay after school. NO child may be left unsupervised after 3:00.
- 3. No student may leave the school grounds after school and return to school without their parent. Anyone who does so will be suspended from school.
- 4. Students must wear their PE uniform or any other SJE apparel for all after school sports team practices.

# St. John Eudes School Athletic Contract Athletic Code of Conduct

I realize that it is a privilege to participate in all athletic activities at St. John Eudes School.

I hereby pledge to live up to my responsibilities as a participant by following the Athletic Code of Conduct.

#### General Code of Conduct for all participants in the St. John Eudes School Sports Program

- 1. I will play for fun and do my best to make sure that the activity is fun for all participants.
- 2. I will be a role model of good sportsmanship and character.
- 3. I will treat all participants, coaches, and the public with respect.
- 4. I will consistently work to improve my skills and be an asset to the TEAM.
- 5. I will play by the rules and never argue or complain about coaches or the officials' decisions.
- 6. I understand that if I receive three or more "NI' s" from three different teachers or one "U" on a trimester report card, I will be ineligible for next season' s sport. I must show improvement to participate again.
- 7. I will attend all practices, games and team meetings. I understand that missing practices or games without permission from the Head Coach or Athletic Director may result to decreased playing time, game suspension and/or removal from the team.

#### Team Sports Code of Conduct for all participants on a St. John Eudes School Sports team

I understand that the athletic director/ Head Coach has the sole responsibility to decide who is on the team and who will play in a game, match, or contest.

- 1. I understand that my participation is a season-long commitment to my team, my coach, and myself. My school commitment comes first, before any park and club teams.
- 2. I will do my best to be at every practice and competition in the sport season. I understand that if I miss practice unexcused two times during this season, I may be dismissed from the team. If I cannot attend practice or a competition, I will contact my coach, A.D. or the school office at the latest, by the morning before practice or competition.
- 3. I will organize my time so that my academic responsibilities do not conflict with practices or competitions. I understand that my team commitment does not excuse me from maintaining academic excellence and that my presence at school is required on days of competition.
- 4. I will be personally responsible for all school athletic equipment checked out to me and will return it in good condition on the day appointed or will pay for the replacement of the gear.

verbal warning to expulsion from the activity.

### **Parents Code of Conduct, and Communication Procedures**

- 1. I will help my child meet responsibilities to the coaches and the team.
- 2. I will make only positive and encouraging comments to all players, coaches, and officials.
- 3. I will support the coach/team and not interfere from the stands or sidelines.
- 4. I will refrain from the use of tobacco and alcohol at all youth activities
- 5. I understand that discussions about coaches and playing time should not take place before, during or after game time. These discussions should be held privately by appointment.
- 6. Follow the 24 hour rule before approaching/contacting the coach.
- 7. I acknowledge that all coaching decisions are final. Any issues I have with a coach must be addressed directly with the coach.
- 8. In the rare instance that there is still no resolution on the issue, the parent should contact the Athletic Director and schedule a meeting with the parent/s, student athlete and Athletic Director.
- 9. If after this meeting the problem continues to exist, the Athletic Director will forward the issue to the school Principal and a possible meeting with all parties involved may be scheduled.

I have received, read, and agree to abide by the Code of Conduct for Parents. Failure to adhere to the above Code of Conduct will result in suspension from viewing the games and/or practices.

### **UNIFORM ORDER FORM**

### **SJE ATHLETICS**

### Parent's Guide

Parents play a critical role in the success of the St. John Eudes Athletic program. Based on the commitment you and your family are making, it is apparent that you recognize as we do the value of participating in athletics. We believe that participation in athletics is an extension of the Catholic education that SJE is based on, and serves as a vital component to the education of the whole person. Participation in athletics is a valuable tool to teach our students the value of hard work and the essence of teamwork. Our athletic department strives to be a positive extension of the excellent SJE education in our classrooms, where lessons in self-discipline, self-confidence and character building through adversity abound. ### KEEP ATHLETICS IN PERSPECTIVE

- Let your child select a sport based on his/her perceived ability and preferences
- Come to as many of your child's games as possible
- Stress the importance of a healthy lifestyle
- Do not support "quitting" as the best way to solve problems, but rather perseverance

### SUPPORT THE PROGRAM

- Be supportive of the coaching staff and respect their professional judgement
- Follow the communication procedure outlined in the sports package
- Model positive Christian/Catholic behavior when attending contests
- Understand the time commitment and needs of the particular sports, many involve significant commitments of time and financial resources
- Help your child follow the guidelines of their athletic contract
- Display by your actions, words, and understanding of the Mission of St. John Eudes School to enhance the image of our school to the community
